

What is the Compact?

The Interstate Medical Licensure Compact (IMLC) offers an expedited pathway to licensure in multiple states for qualified candidates. The process is expedited by leveraging existing data previously verified by the State of Principle Licensure (SPL). The SPL will verify eligibility and conduct a new background check. Once this is complete, any of the participating states can be selected in order to receive a license. Additional states can be selected for up to one year.

Smooth & simple process

- Online application (three to four pages), fingerprinting, and email correspondence
- Malpractice? No problem and no extra paperwork

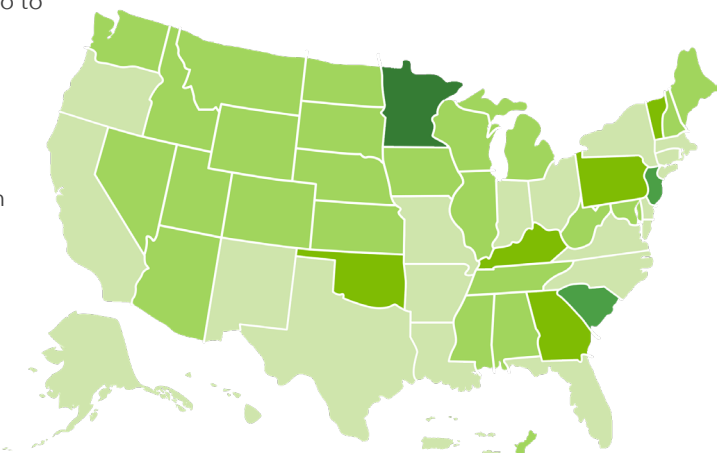


How does the Compact benefit facilities?

- Faster and easier licensing process for physicians (two to five weeks)
- Fewer speed bumps in the licensing process (no board meetings, primary-source verifications, or legal reviews)
- Physicians currently participating in the Compact can get additional licenses quickly (typically less than one week), increasing your pool of candidates for an urgent need

As of November 2019, there are 24 participating states in the Compact and four states have passed legislation to be active participants in the future.
